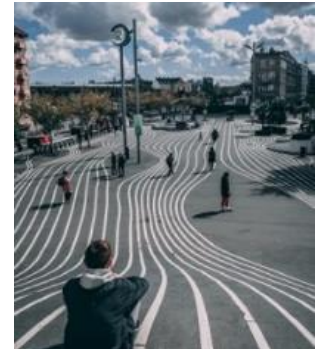


Sound in Urban Planning

Yesterday, Danish Sound Cluster (DSC) held a seminar on Sound in Urban Planning in which DMdB's founder, Douglas Manvell participated in a panel discussion with Martin Hallberg (Efterklang) and Liselott Stenfeldt (Gehl) on soundscapes, sound walks & sound design for everyday outdoor sound environments. The event was very popular, gathering 75 people from a wide range of companies and institutions in Denmark. And, there were several online attendees from all over the world for the main speaker, Arnthrudur Gísladóttir (Niras).

The seminar was set up to discuss how to better integrate expert knowledge on sound in urban planning and design practice including how to strengthen interdisciplinary collaboration between acousticians and urban planners, architects, entrepreneurs and other partners. In addition, the topics of soundscaping and urban sound design as ways of both improving the urban environment as well as aids to bring in sound at an earlier stage of urban planning were raised.
